

Cookies Policy

a. What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small amount of data, which often includes a unique identifier that is sent to your computer or mobile phone (referred to here as a "device") browser from a website's computer and is stored on your device's hard drive. Each website can send its own cookie to your browser if your browser's preferences allow it, but (to protect your privacy) your browser only permits a website to access the cookies it has already sent to you, not the cookies sent to you by other websites. Many websites do this whenever a user visits their website in order to track online traffic flows.

On the 3D Events website, we use cookies to analyse site visits and allow us to tailor the website to suit our users. Users have the opportunity to set their devices to accept all cookies, to notify them when a cookie is issued, or not to receive cookies at any time. The last of these means that certain personalised features cannot then be provided to that user and accordingly they may not be able to take full advantage of all of the website's features. Each browser is different, so check the "Help" menu of your browser to learn how to change your cookie preferences.

b. How does the 3D Events website use cookies?

Information supplied by cookies can help us to analyse the amount of visitors to our site, which browser or device was used and help us to understand how our site was found. This information can help us to provide you with a better user experience.

c. Third Party Cookies on 3D Events

Please note that during your visits to the 3D Events website you may notice some cookies that are not related to 3D Events. When you visit a page with content embedded from, for example, Facebook or Twitter, you may be presented with cookies from these websites. 3D Events does not control the dissemination of these cookies. You should check the third party websites for more information about these.

d. 3D Events cookies and how to reject cookies?

How to control and delete cookies

3D Events will not use cookies to collect personally identifiable information about you. However, if you wish to restrict or block the cookies which are set by the 3D Events website, or indeed any other website, you can do this through your browser settings. The Help function within your browser should tell you how.

Alternatively, you may wish to visit www.aboutcookies.org which contains comprehensive information on how to do this on a wide variety of browsers. You will also find details on how to delete cookies from your computer as well as more general information about cookies. For information on how to do this on the browser of your mobile phone you will need to refer to your handset manual.

Please be aware that restricting cookies may impact on the functionality of the 3D Events website.
